## PSALM 84

Psalm 84 is the psalm this week. It is a pilgrim psalm, a psalm with a journey. It is a psalm of longing for God's presence and delight for those found in Him.

We sang 'better is one day in Your courts' this past Sunday and the words from that song come from this week's psalm. There is a line in that song that jumped out at me as we sang it last Sunday, the song says, 'to find You in the place Your glory dwells'

My thought was... this means to find You in me, I am the place His glory dwells, I am in Christ, He is in me. That's huge.

## BABES & TOTS

We are going to give the children opportunity to express their praise this Sunday. We are going to use the second half of verse 2 as the focus for these little ones, it says:

With my whole being, body and soul,  
I will shout joyfully to the living God.

These little people do everything with their whole being, there is no half heartedness about them and we will help them find lots of ways to shout their praise to God.

We will use the story of Jesus' entry to Jerusalem and the children who were shouting their welcome to Him. You can find this story in Matthew 21:1-11

## bigKIDS & TRANSFORMERS
